Michigan's expungement statute allows a person who is convicted of only **one felony and not more than 2 misdemeanors to ask to set aside a felony conviction. A person with two misdemeanor convictions and no felonies can ask the court to set aside the misdemeanors. A person convicted of CSC 4 before Jan. 14, 2015 can ask to set aside if no other convictions besides 2 "minor offenses" as defined by law.** There are exceptions that do not allow those convicted of "life offenses" and certain other crimes, including many sex offenses, to ask for an expungement of their criminal record. Most who are eligible to apply must wait at least 5 years after the imposition of the sentence or after the completion of jail/prison, probation or parole.
